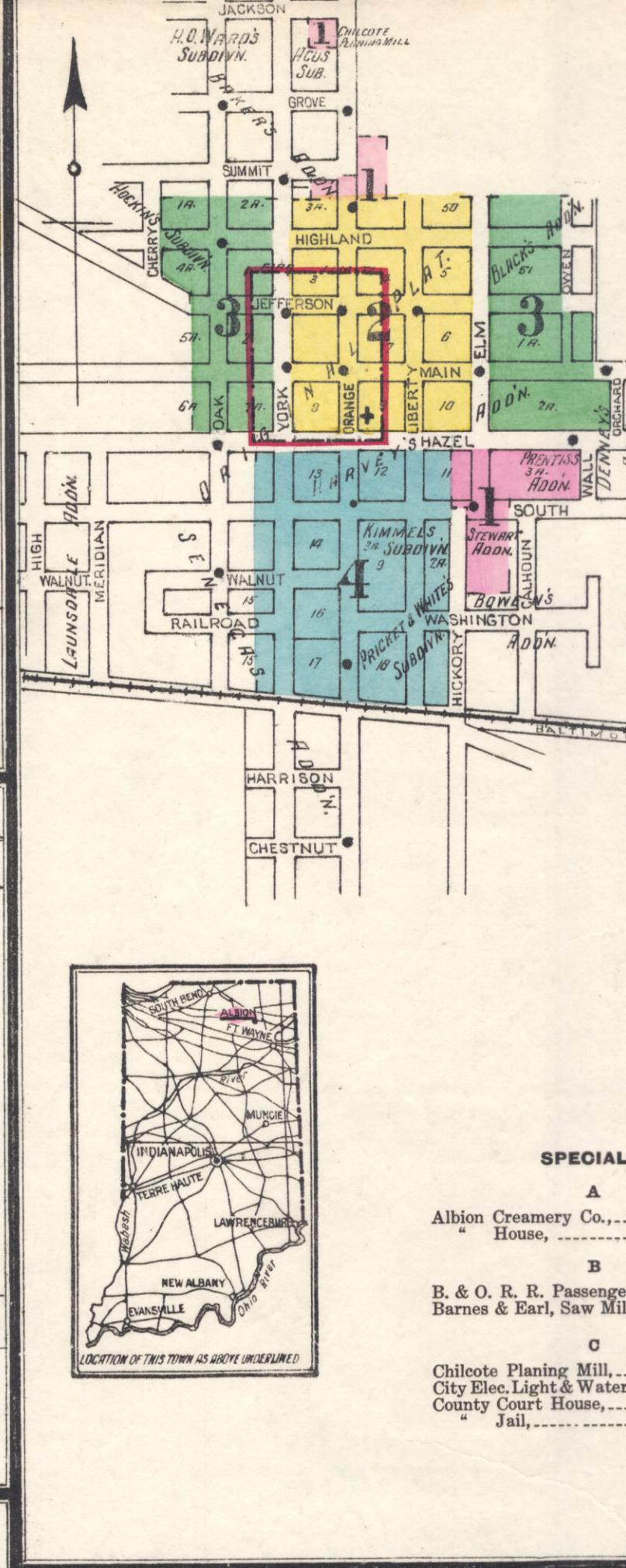
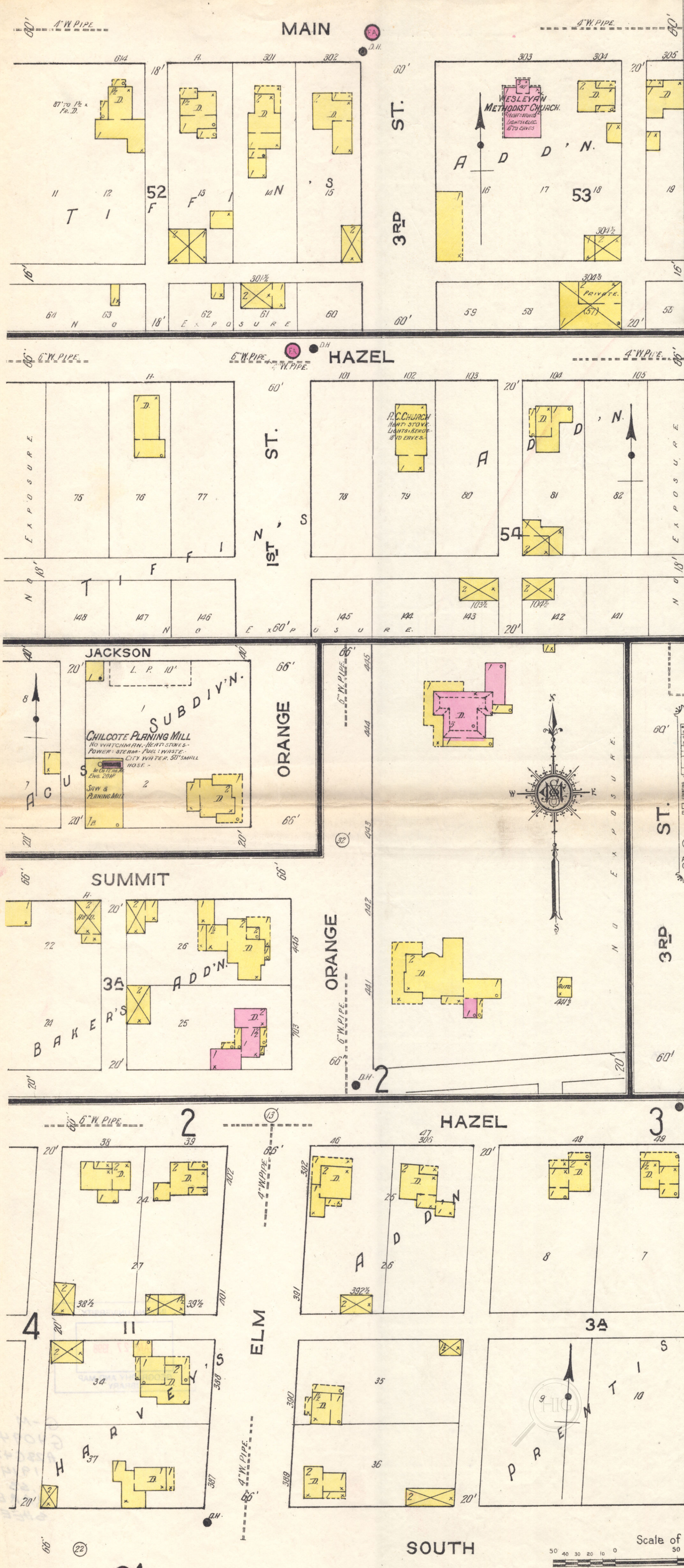

WATER FACILITIES:
 Direct pressure, 2 Worthington F.P.s 8"x12"x7"x10" capacity 300,000 gallons each per 24 hours, supplied by three 6" wells. Average daily consumption 50,000 gallons. Domestic pressure 80 lbs. fire pressure 120 lbs. 1/2 miles 4" to 10" mains, 2 double hydrants. Installed in 1885 & a 300' extension in 1915.

FIRE DEPT:
 Volunteer, 36 men - 3 hose carts, 1,000' 2 1/2" hose - 1 hand H&L wagon - 12 auxiliary fire alarm boxes. Public alarm whistle & bell. Grades as shown - 1 mile brick & asphalt pavement, Main & Orange Sts. - Public lights elec. arc & incandescent.
