



WATER FACILITIES:

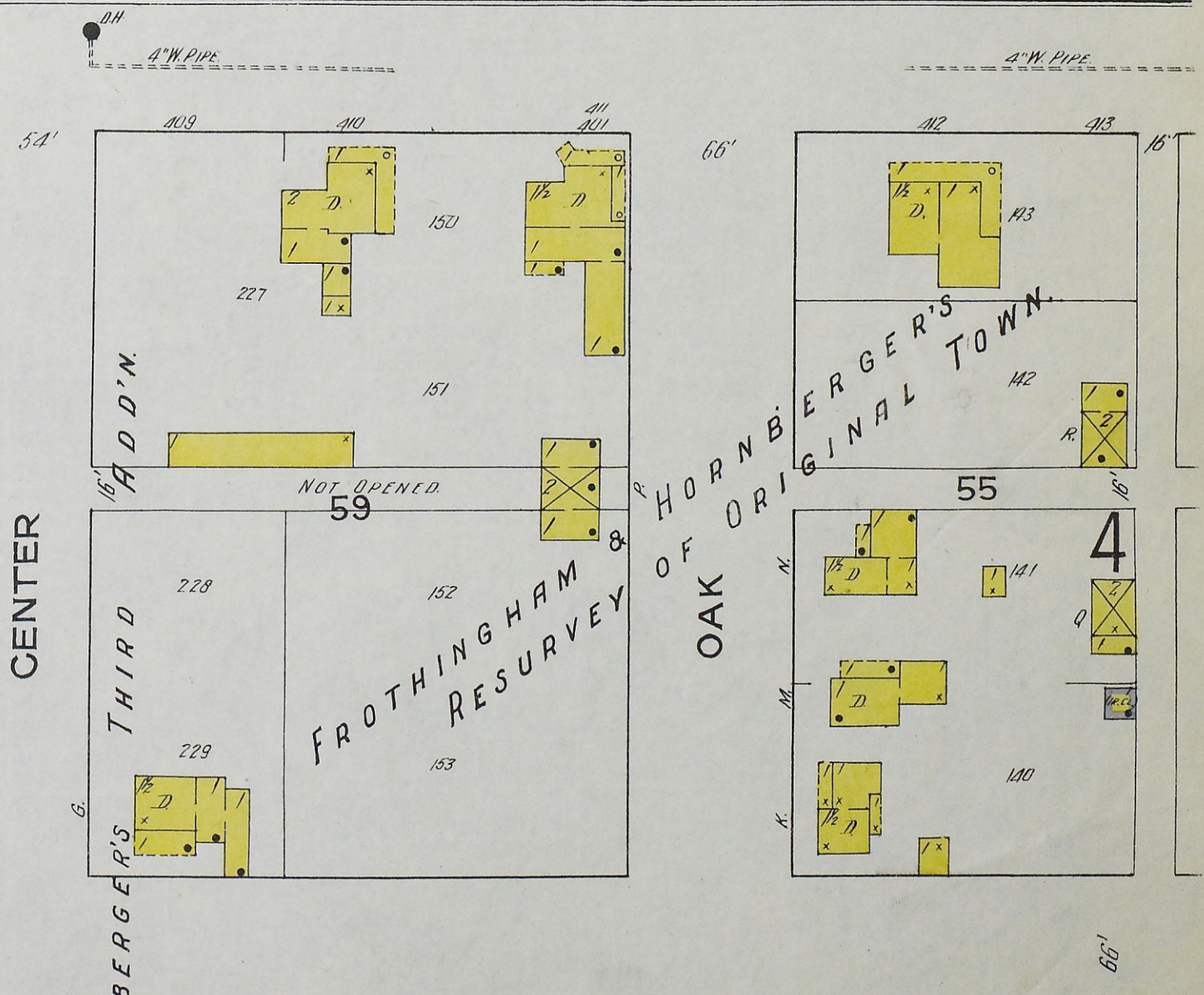
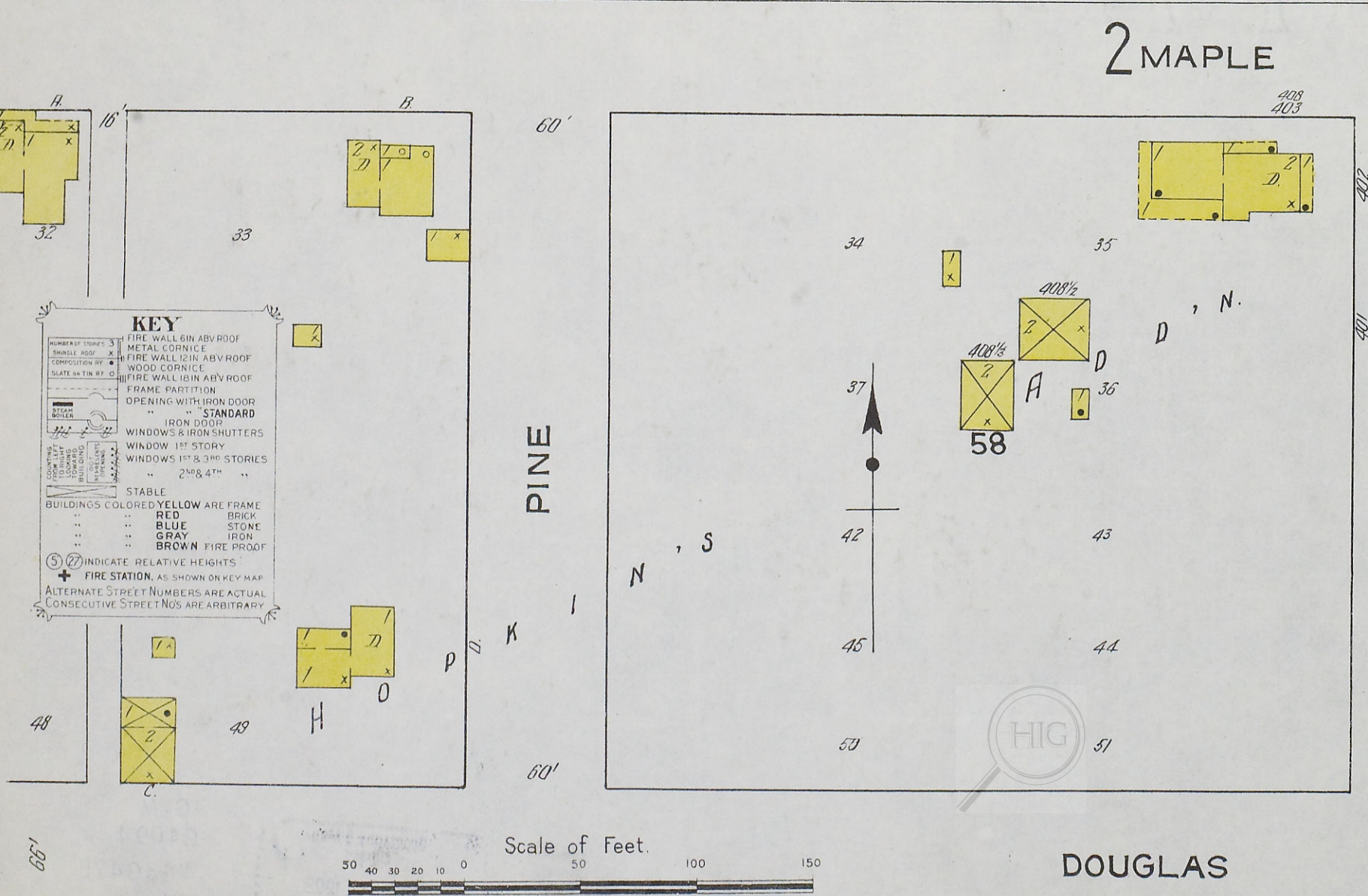
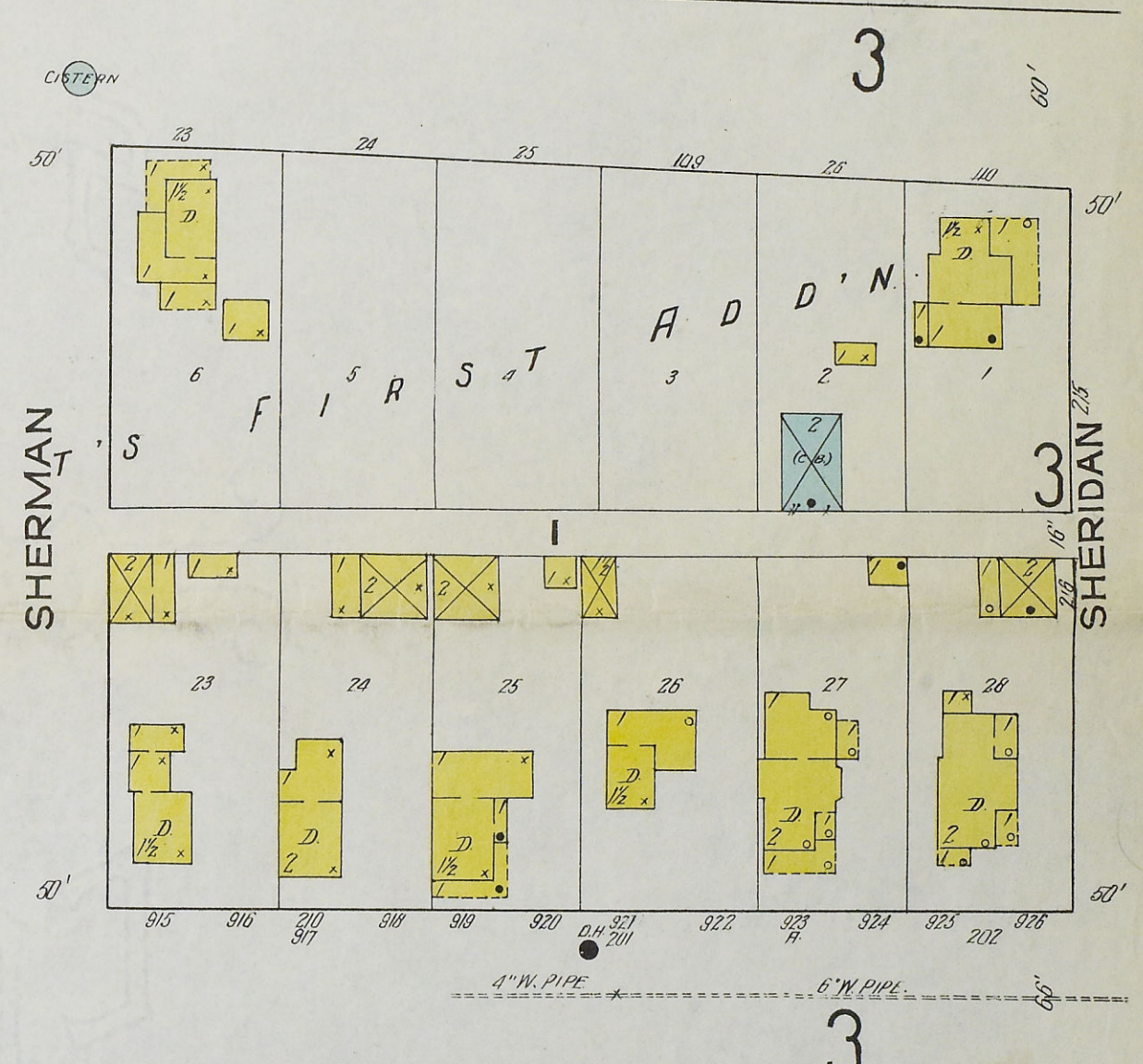
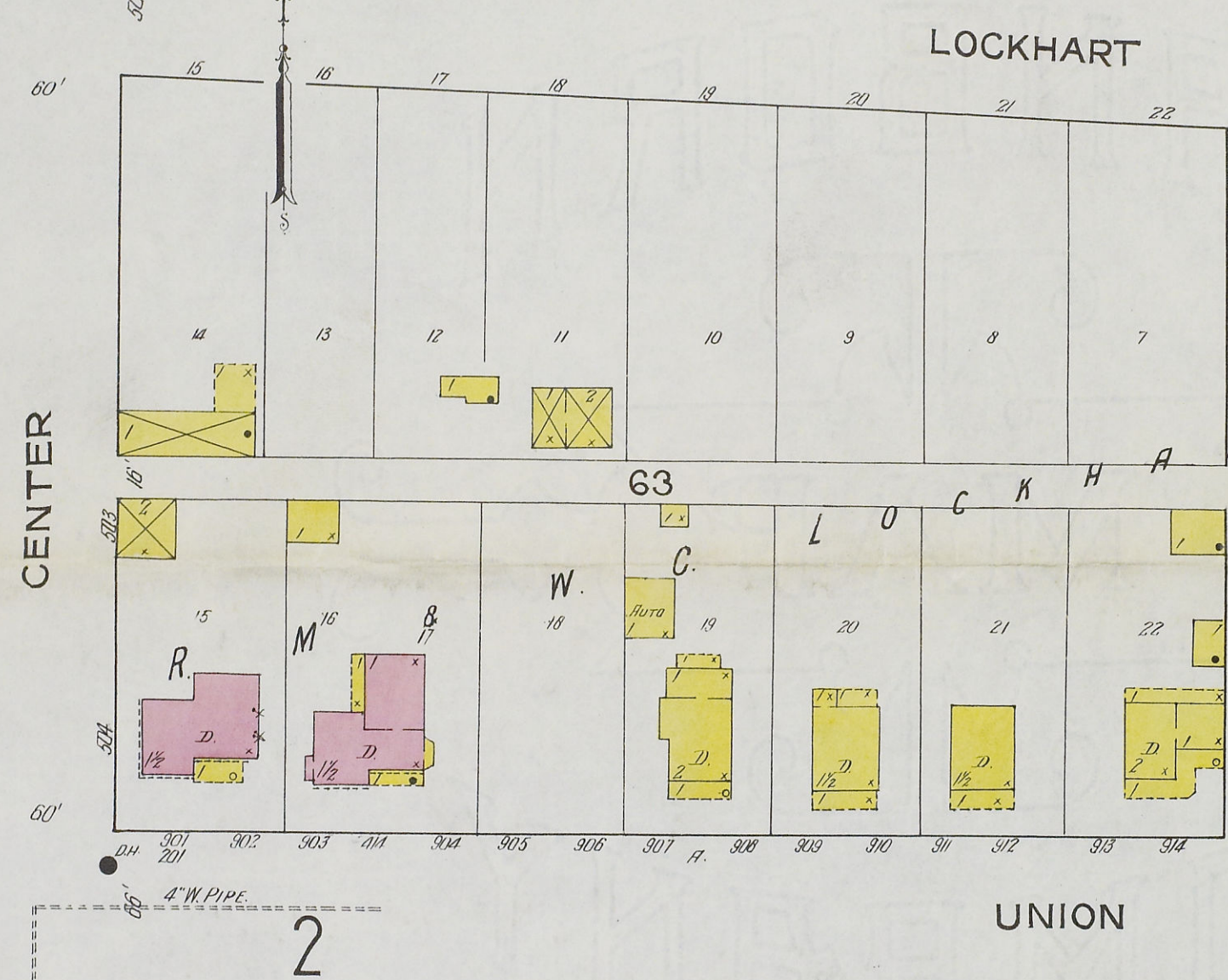
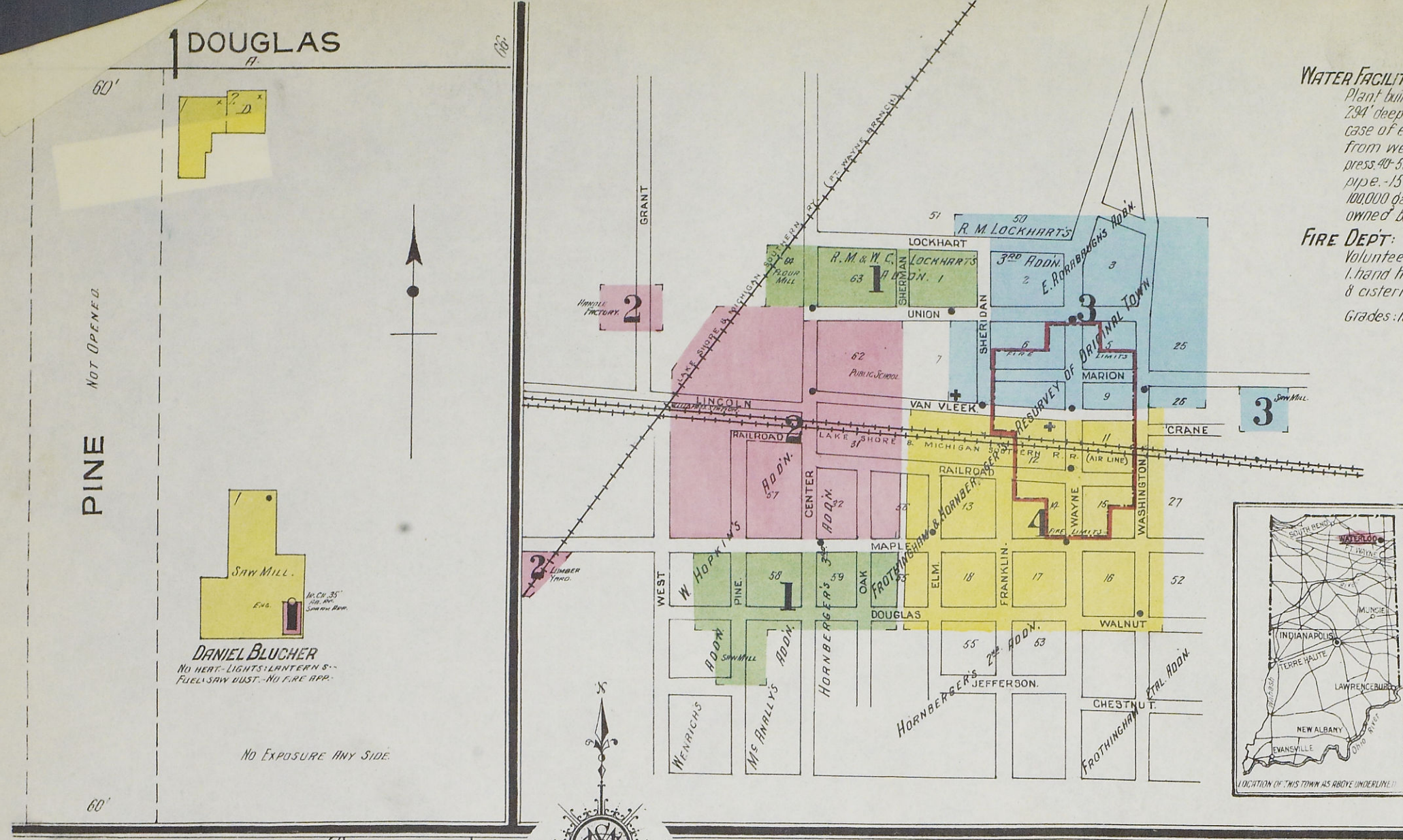
Plant built in 1902. Source of supply two 6" wells, 215 & 234' deep. Smith-Kyle duplex steam pump 12" x 7" x 12" used in case of emergency. Two 400 g.p.m. rotary electric pumps drawing from wells. 200,000 gals capacity each in 24 hours. Domestic pressure 40-55 lbs. fire pressure 100 lbs. per sq. in. 2 miles of 8" x 8" cast iron pipe. 15 double hydrants. Stand pipe 120' high, capacity 100,000 gallons. Average daily consumption 30,000 gals. Water Works owned by Indiana Utilities Co.

FIRE DEPT:

Volunteer, 20 men including chief, 1 hand hose reel, 1 hand hose wagon, 1 H. & L. wagon, 1 hand engine, 8 cisterns, distrib. fire alarm bells, telephone service. Grades level. Public lights electric.
