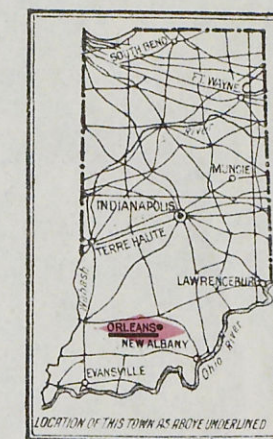

Water Works installed in 1916. Gravity & direct pressure system. Water pumped from two 8' wells, 104' dia deep by 2 Cook duplex deep well pumps (electric driven, size each 6"x4", capacity each 120 gals. per minute) into 60,000 gal. steel gravity tank, elev. 100' above ground on steel tower. Base of tank is also about 112' above business portion of town at Public Sq., also have 12" & 8" well to draw from for emergency. 1-De Lev booster fire pump, capacity 300 gals. per minute. Pumps are controlled by electricity from Orleans Light & Power Plant (owned by Kelsey Bros) when pressure gauge registers 50 lbs., indicating that water in gravity tank at Water Works has dropped about 6' engineer at Power Plant throws switch, starting pumps. 1 & 3 x pumping until tank is filled to capacity, pumps stopping automatically. Domestic pressure 55 lbs., Direct fire pressure from booster pump, 30 lbs. - 4 miles 4" to 8" water mains, laid 1916. 40 double hydrants. Average daily consumption: 200,000 gals.-

Volunteer Fire Dept. with Chief & Assistants being organized. - 2 Hand Hose Reels, each carrying 500' 2" C.R. L. hose in good condition. - 1 Hook & Ladder hand drawn. - 1 Champion Chem. Engine cap'd 60 gals., 100' 1/4" rubber hose. - 6 Royal chemical ext'rs. - Fire alarm: telephones & bell on roof of Telephone Exchange Bld'g. controlled by telephone operator.

Grades: level. Streets: partly graveled. Public lights: electric.
No night watchman.
