WATER FACILITIES.

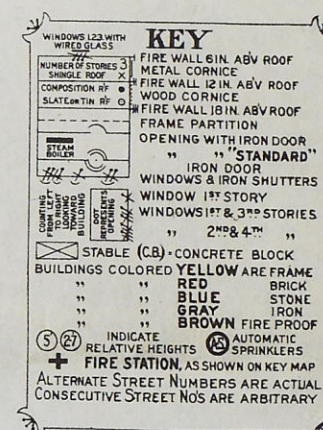
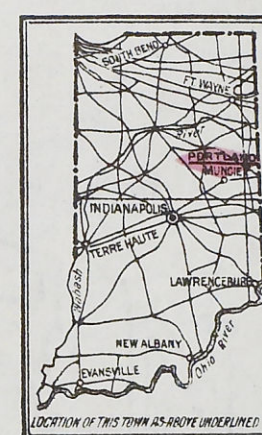
WATER FACILITIES: Direct pressure system of water works. Water supply from seven 8" driven wells. One Blake compound duplex steam pump, (10-16-102-12), capy 4 million galls. per 24 hours. Two Delaval elect. centrifugal pumps, capy 500 galls. each per min.

About 122 miles of water pipes 3" to 12" diam. laid in 1895. 142 double hydrants. Domestic pressure 55 lbs. Fire pressure 80 lbs. per sq. inch. Average daily consumption about 450,000 galls.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Two paid men, Ten volunteers, Two horses. One triple combination auto truck (American-La France) with pump of 500 galls. per min, 40 gall chemical tank and 2500 ft. 2½" cotton-rubber lined hose.
