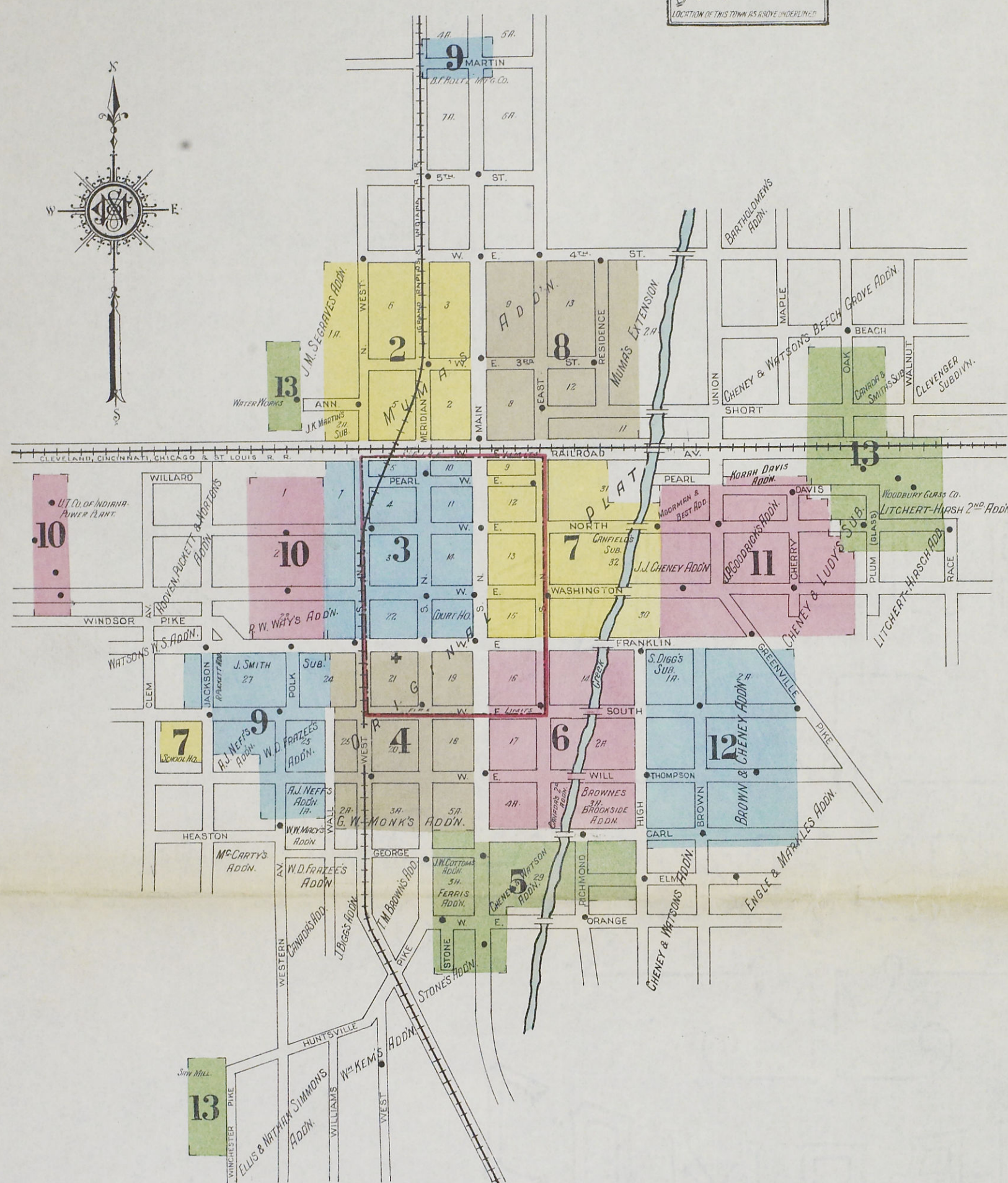

WATER FACILITIES:

WATER FACILITIES: Direct pressure system of Water Works—One Gould motor driven triple pump and one Gould gas engine driven triple pump 3' x 1' each, one Gould motor driven triple pump 10' x 12'. Total capacity 1000,000 gallons per twenty-four hours: Supply from five 8' wells 200' deep for domestic and from 130,000 gallon reservoir, supplied by seepage, for fire purposes. Domestic pressure 45 pounds, fire pressure 30 to 100 pounds. Average daily consumption 300,000 gallons. Eleven miles 4" to 12" water mains, laid 1900. 4 triple & 62 double hydrants.

FIRE DEPT:

One Chief and two paid men, ten volunteers paid per call, three horses, One 2 horse hose wagon, one 1 horse H. & L. truck, 2100' 2" C.R.L. hose. Four 6 gallon chemical tanks. - Alarm by telephone, alarm bell on fire station. -

Grades: level. Principal streets paved with brick, others graveled.
Public lights: electric.
