Water Supply from White River. 2 Hughes Steam Pump Co's Compound Condensing Pumps, Capacity 4 Million Galls each per 24 hours, Steam always up. 2 Men on night duty. Each pump is capable of supplying a dozen fire streams together with other duties and maintain the pressure. 19 Miles of Water Pipes, 4" to 20" diam. 149 Double Public Hydrants & 16 Private Fire Hydrants. Domestic Pressure 60 lbs. Fire Pressure 90 to 100 lbs. per Sq. Inch. (This system has been tested at 165 lbs)
