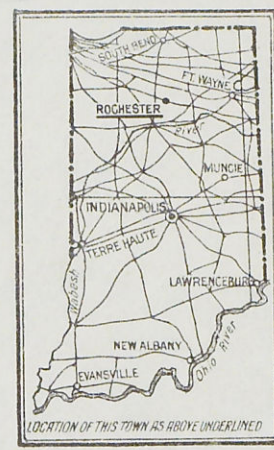

WATER FACILITIES

Stand pipe and direct pressure system of water works under municipal ownership. Water supply from Lake Manitow, 1 1/2 miles S.E. of Post Office. Flows by gravity into two reservoirs at pumping station, one 50,000 galls. the other 20,000 galls. capacity. Two Smith-Vaile compound duplex force pumps (10x16x42) capacity one million galls. each per 24 hours draw from these reservoirs also from Mill Creek. Stand pipe of 105,738 galls. cap'y 12 ft. diam. 120 ft. high.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Paid, Eight men, Two horses. One combination hose, ladder and chemical wagon with 1000 ft. 2 1/2" hose (250 ft. 2 1/2" hose in reserve), 35 gal. chemical tank, 250 ft. 1" chemical hose and two 5 gal. chemical extinguishers. 500 ft. of 2 1/2" hose is new, balance is in good condition. One hand hose cart, not used. Fire alarm by bell, also by whistle at pumping station. Fire limits as shown.
