WATER FACILITIES:

Stand pipe and direct pressure system of water works. Water supply from Lake Manitowish, 16 miles S.E. of Post Office flows by gravity through race and 20" main into two reservoirs near pumping station, capacity of reservoirs 61,963 gals.

Four pumps, viz: One 3-mth - Vaile compound double-acting pump, 100-135 gals. per min. run by 20 h.p. motor. One electric pump, 100-200 gals. per min. run by 50 H.P. motor. One electric pump, capacity 500 gals. each per min. and one electric pump, capacity 1000 gals. per min. run by 50 H.P. motor. Pumps also connected to Mill Creek.

Stand pipe 12" x 125' capacity 105,356 gals.

5 1/2 miles of water pipes, 4" to 20" diam. System installed in 1893. Main extensions 1893-1900. 100' and 1 1/2 mile hydrants.

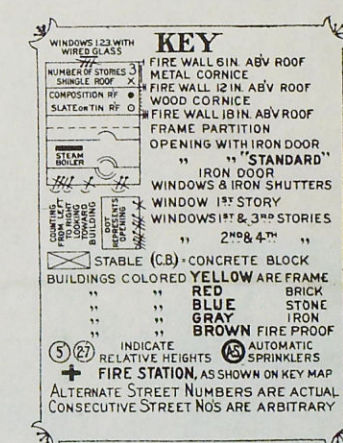
Domestic pressure 40 to 45 lbs. Fire pressure 45 to 50 lbs.

Average daily consumption about 525,000 gals.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

One day and night man and six volunteers.
One 40 HP. So. Bend motor truck with 1000 ft. 2 1/2" cotton rubber lined hose, one 40 gall. chemical tank and 200 ft. chemical hose. 800 ft. 2 1/2" cotton rubber lined hose in reserve. Two horse hose wagon held in reserve drawn by trailer.

Fire alarm by telephones and siren whistle on water works.
