



WATER FACILITIES:
Water works owned & operated by private corporation. Water supply, Ohio River, installed in 1904 with 8 miles of mains with an increase to 10 miles of 4" to 10" mains at present. Water pumped from river with 2 Smith Reile pumps. 1 compound duplex pump 12x10x10x12 & 1 simple duplex pump 16x10x12. Capacity of each 1,000,000 gals. to storage tank elev. 275' above corner of Second & Mechanic Sts. capacity 200,000 gals. giving 120 lbs. domestic pressure & direct fire pressure of 135 lbs. - 8" suction & 7" discharge into a 10" main - 88 double fire hydr. - daily consumption 240,000 gals.

FIRE DEPT:
Volunteer - 4 members incl. 1 hose house at West Aurora formerly known as Cochran with 28 members partly paid with 1 steam engine "America" capacity 450 gals. per min., 1 hose wagon with 800' 2 1/2" C.R. hose in good condition. 1 H.A. L. Truck, horses available at Cochran Furniture Co. at rear of hose house. Hand pump. 1 hose cart in City with 13 members. 2 horses in use during day - 1 hose wagon with 800' 2 1/2" C.R. hose - 1 H.A. L. Truck with 350' 2 1/2" hose & 2 seal chems. - 1 eng. ho. with 2 Rivers steam ends, 1 out of order - 1 hand reel with 200' 2" hose & 650' of hose in reserve, all hose in good condition. - Fire alarm, bell on hose ho. Streets macadamized, grades rolling with a difference in elevation of 80'. - Electric street lamps.
