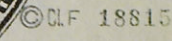


WATER FACILITIES
Only 1/2 operated by private corporation. Water supply 12 driven wells, eight 400' deep. 1400 acre reservoir, capacity 600000 gals. 1 stand pipe 40x1 1/2" capacity 100000 gals. base of which is elevated 22' above Court Ho square. 2 Lead & W. Dunn & Gordon compound duplex pumps, capacity one million gallons per 24 hours & one Worthington pump, capacity 500000 gals per 24 hours. 40 lbs domestic pressure 60 lbs fire pressure. 100 lbs pressure. 10 miles of water mains from 4" to 10. 6 miles of which were laid in 1890, & increased every year until present condition. 105 Double hydrants.
